General facts

Zagreb is the capital city of Croatia. It is located in the northwest of the country where it takes place around 641 km². The city of Zagreb has approximately 800 000 citizens.

Croatian is the official language of Croatia. The Croatian Kuna (HRK) is the currency of Croatia (1 euro is around 7.40 HRK).

Public transportation

Public transportation in Zagreb is very well developed. In the first zone, it consists of a net of trams and bus lines (ZET). The best places for buying paper tickets are kiosks. The tickets can be bought in several variations: ticket which costs 4 HRK is valid for 30 minutes, 7 HRK ticket (60 minutes), 10 HRK (90 minutes) and 30 HRK (daily ticket). Paper tickets are used for both, trams and buses. Also, you can buy tickets from drivers in trams and buses, but the prices are higher. The fine for driving without a ticket is 250 HRK. Zagreb has only one airport (Franjo Tuđman Airport) which is located 17 km from city centre. The best option for transfer between the airport and the city center is the ZET bus line 290 ZAGREB (KVATERNIKOV TRG) - ZRAČNA LUKA - VELIKA GORICA. The most popular and cheapest taxi drivers in Zagreb are Uber, Bolt and Cammeo. It is also possible to rent-a-bike for approximately 75 HRK (10 euro) (https://www.rentabikezagreb.com/).
